NOTICE INVITING TENDER

The Director, (AMD), Begumpet, Hyderabad invites on behalf of the President of India, separate item-wise sealed tenders in two parts (TECHNICAL and COMMERCIAL) from eligible Drilling contractors, for each of the following works in Chitrial Area, Nalgonda District, Andhra Pradesh:

Parties should fulfill the following eligibility criteria (Documentary evidence to be submitted) for issue of Tender Documents. For downloaded tenders, cost of tender and documentary evidence in support of eligibility criteria should be submitted with Technical Bid.

(A) TECHNICAL:

- (a) Availability of minimum of 3 DTH rigs of required capacity for each work at S.No.1 & 2.
(b) Experience in drilling for mineral/geo-technical exploration.

(B) FINANCIAL: Experience of successfully completed works during the last 5 years;

- (i) Three similar completed works costing not less than 25% of cost put to tender
(or) Two similar completed works costing not less than 40% of cost put to tender
(or) one similar completed work costing not less than 60% of cost put to tender.
(ii) Solvency of amount equal to 25% of cost put to tender. The Solvency certificate should not be earlier than one year from the last date of receipt of tender.
(iii) Average annual financial turnover in the last three financial years should be at least 30% of cost put to tender.

2	Inclination of the borehole: All boreholes are Vertical																																																																																													
3	Number of Rigs: The party should possess minimum number of DTH rigs of required capacity for each of the item as mentioned in the NIT to be eligible for consideration.																																																																																													
4	Formations to be drilled: Quartzite, Shale and Granite																																																																																													
5	Contact Person(s): The bidders are advised to visit the areas before offering their bids. 6	<p>Location of Drilling areas:</p> <p>CHITRIAL AREA : Chitrial Area in Nalgonda District of Andhra Pradesh is approachable through 101Km. State Highway from Hyderabad to Mallepally and 7 Km. road to Devarkonda and through 24 km road via Pollepalli to Chitrial Village in the Rajiv Gandhi Wild Life Sanctuary (Nidgul Reserve Forest).</p>																																																																																													
7	Joint Venture: Two or more companies/contractors may enter into a joint partnership and the lead contractor may submit the bid(s)																																																																																													
8	Bid Capacity: In case a party quotes for more than one work, the second and subsequent bids of the same party will be considered only, if they fulfill the combined eligibility criteria in respect of availability of rigs, solvency, annual turn over, work experience etc for all the works quoted.																																																																																													
9	<p>Issue of Tender Documents: Only those applicants submitting documentary evidence in support of the eligibility criteria will be issued tender documents. In case of tender documents downloaded from website, documentary evidence in support of eligibility criteria should be furnished along with the tender failing which the tender is liable to be rejected. However, issue of tender documents will not automatically mean that the tenderers are considered qualified. The cost of Tender Documents shall be payable by crossed demand draft (non-refundable), drawn on any nationalized bank in favour of the Pay & Accounts Officer, AMD/DAE payable at SECUNDERABAD. Cheques, Bank Guarantees and Postal Orders will not be accepted. 12	General Instructions for Submission of Tender: Bids should be submitted in sealed covers in the following manner.	
	(a)	The tenders shall be in two parts viz. Part-I (i.e. Technical bid) and Part-II (i.e. Commercial bid). Part-I shall contain the documents in support of Cost of Tender Document (in case of downloaded tenders), EMD, the details of technical qualifications, competence of the tenderer supported by certificates as required vide eligibility criteria for issue of tender documents specified in the NIT.
	(b)	The part – II shall be the commercial bid containing the schedule of quantities issued along with tender documents, duly filled in by the tenderer along with commercial terms if any.
	(c)	Part-I and Part-II bids shall be in separate sealed covers, duly super scribing on the covers with the details of bid i.e. "NIT No., Name of the work, Part-I/Part-II, Name of the tenderer, due date of opening of the tender" etc. Both the sealed covers should be kept in a common sealed cover duly super scribing the details of the bid.
	(d)	No bid shall be considered unless accompanied by the Earnest Money and non-refundable Tender Document cost (in case of downloaded Tenders)
13	Receipt of Bids: Tenders will be received by the In Charge, Contract Drilling on any working day up to 1600 hrs. and up to 1300 hrs on the last date of submission shown in NIT.	
14	Opening of Bids: Part-I i.e. Technical bid of the tenders will be opened on the dates and time mentioned in NIT at AMD Complex, 1-10-153/156, Begumpet, Hyderabad-500 629, (AP), INDIA. Commercial bids of only those tenderers found technically suitable by a Committee of experts constituted by AMD will be opened and evaluated for award of work. Date and time of opening of the commercial bid will be intimated later to the short-listed tenderers.	
15	Quoted rates should be written both in figures and words. The rate should be inclusive of Service Tax and any other Central/State taxes and duties.	
16	All corrections should be authenticated / signed.	
17	Tenders with any conditions, including conditional rebate(s) shall be rejected forthwith.	
18	Validity: Offers should be valid for a minimum of 180 days from the date of opening of the tender.	
19	The Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration & Research (AMD) is not under any obligation to accept the lowest Bid/Bids and reserves the right to reject any or all the bids without assigning any reason what-so-ever and also to distribute the work and allot the work/works to more than one Bidder, at its sole discretion.	
20	If the office happens to be closed on the date of submission/opening of the bid as specified, the bids will be submitted / opened on the next working day at the same time and venue.	
21	The Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration & Research (AMD) would not be liable for any delay in submission of bid by a bidder on account of obstruction or delay by any outside element / agency and takes no responsibility for delay, loss or non-receipt of documents sent by post.	
22	SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:	
	As the drilling area (CHITRIAL) falls under Rajiv Gandhi Wildlife Sanctuary (RGWS) (Tiger Reserve), the following steps should be taken to conserve and protect fauna and flora:	
	i)	(a) Drilling should be restricted to dawn to dusk only .
		(b) No tree removal/uprooting.
		(c) Restoration of ground to normal status after work,
		(d) Minimum movement of personnel and vehicles,
		(e) No camping in sanctuary area except night watchman,
		(f) To prevent fire hazards, POL should not be stored,
		(g) Water requirement to be met by contractor's own arrangement,
		(h) No movement of vehicles in the night,
		(i) Fencing of the drill site to avoid harm to wildlife,
		(j) Use of existing roads,
		(k) Noise level should be limited as per the guidelines of Government of India under Noise, Pollution (Regulation and Control) Rules.
	ii)	The compensation to the land owners for the drill site and making of approach road/track should be directly negotiated and paid by the contractor.
	iii)	The contractor should be adequately equipped with regard to all drilling inventory such as casing, rods, bits etc. of appropriate requirement.
