The Director, (AMD), Begumpet, Hyderabad invites on behalf of the President of India, separate item-wise sealed tenders from eligible Drilling contractors, for the following works in the areas of Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh.

Parties should fulfill the following eligibility criteria (Documentary evidence to be submitted) for issue of Tender Documents. For downloaded tenders, cost of tender and documentary evidence in support of eligibility criteria should be submitted with the Bid.

(A) TECHNICAL:

- (a) Availability of minimum of 1 DTH rig of required capacity for each work at S.No.1 & 2.
(b) Experience in drilling for mineral/geo-technical exploration.

(B) FINANCIAL: Experience of successfully completed works during the last 5 years;

- (i) Three similar completed works costing not less than 25% of cost put to tender
(or) Two similar completed works costing not less than 40% of cost put to tender
(or) one similar completed work costing not less than 60% of cost put to tender.
(ii) Solvency of amount equal to 25% of cost put to tender. The Solvency certificate should not be earlier than one year from the last date of receipt of tender.
(iii) Average annual financial turnover in the last three financial years should be at least 30% of cost put to tender.

2	Inclination of the borehole: All boreholes are Vertical																																																																																													
3	Number of Rigs: The party should possess minimum number of rigs of required capacity as mentioned in the NIT to be eligible for consideration.																																																																																													
4	Formations to be drilled: : Sandstone, Shale and Basic rocks in Jhirpa area and Arenite and Granite in Burgibhata area :																																																																																													
5	Contact Person(s): The bidders are advised to contact the Regional Director,Central Region, Regional Centre for Exploration and Reasearch, AMD/DAE, Civil Lines, Nagpur – 440 001 (Phone No: 0712-2564469) for any clarifications and for visiting the areas.																																																																																													
6	<p>Location of Drilling area: Jhirpa-Bandhi-Kharatolia area in Chhindwara District of Madhya Pradesh is situated on Chhindwara – Piparia road at 50 km north from Tamia Block of Chhindwara district. Piparia is the nearest railhead on Itarsi – Allahabad section. Piparia tehsil is 260 km from Nagpur and is well connected by all season road. Investigation area lies 35 km south of Piparia on an all season road. Burgibhata area in Bastar District of Chhattisgarh is 45 km from Jagdalpur. Jagdalpur, the major town near to the proposed drilling area is well connected by road and rail from Raipur by NH- 43, Dantewada by NH – 16 and Hyderabad via Bhadrachalam by NH - 221. Road diastance of Jagadalpur from Raipur is 300 km (NH – 43) . It can be reached from Jagdalpur by metal road up to Mangalapur via Kamnar (35 km) and further by 10 km kutchu but motorable road to drill site.</p>																																																																																													
7	Joint Venture: Two or more companies/contractors may enter into a joint partnership and the lead contractor may submit the bid(s)																																																																																													
8	Bid Capacity: In case a party quotes for more than one work, the second and subsequent bids of the same party will be considered only, if they fulfill the combined eligibility criteria in respect of availability of rigs, solvency, annual turn over, work experience etc for all the works quoted.																																																																																													
9	<p>Issue of Tender Documents: Only those applicants submitting documentary evidence in support of the eligibility criteria will be issued tender documents. In case of tender documents downloaded from website, documentary evidence in support of eligibility criteria should be furnished along with the tender failing which the tender is liable to be rejected. However, issue of tender documents will not automatically mean that the tenderers are considered qualified. (b)	Cheque, Bank Guarantees and Postal Orders will not be accepted towards EMD.
(c)	EMD should be enclosed in a separate envelop along with the Bid.
(d)	The tenders without Earnest Money Deposit in the prescribed manner are liable to be rejected.
12	General Instructions for Submission of Tender: Bids should be submitted in sealed covers in the following manner.
(a)	Bidder is required to submit his Bids in sealed covers separately for each item of work giving reference to this Tender Notice No. and date, duly superscribing on the cover with the details of bids i.e. "NIT No., Name of the work, Tender No., name of the tenderer, due date of opening of the tender" etc.
(d)	No bid shall be considered unless accompanied by the Earnest Money and non-refundable TD cost (applicable for bidders who download the TD from Website for submitting their Bid).
13	Receipt of Bids: Tenders will be received by the In Charge, Contract Drilling on any working day up to 1600 hrs. and up to 1300 hrs on the last date of submission shown in NIT.
14	Opening of Bids: The tenders will be opened on the dates mentioned against each item of work at AMD Complex, 1-10-153/156, Begumpet, Hyderabad-16, (AP), INDIA
15	Quoted rates should be written both in figures and words. The rate should be inclusive of Service Tax and any other Central/State taxes and duties.
16	All corrections should be authenticated / signed.
17	Tenders with any conditions, including conditional rebate(s) shall be rejected forthwith.
18	Validity: Offers should be valid for a minimum of 180 days from the date of opening of the tender.
19	The Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration & Research (AMD) is not under any obligation to accept the lowest Bid/Bids and reserves the right to reject any or all the bids without assigning any reason what-so-ever and also to distribute the work and allot the work/works to more than one Bidder, at its sole discretion.
20	If the office happens to be closed on the date of submission/opening of the bid as specified, the bids will be submitted / opened on the next working day at the same time and venue.
21	The Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration & Research (AMD) would not be liable for any delay in submission of bid by a bidder on account of obstruction or delay by any outside element / agency and takes no responsibility for delay, loss or non-receipt of documents sent by post.
22	SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:
i)	The compensation to the land owners for the drill site and making of approach road/track should be directly negotiated and paid by the contractor.
ii)	The contractor should be adequately equipped with regard to all drilling inventory such as casing, rods, bits etc. of appropriate requirement.
